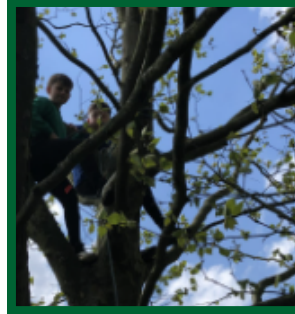
We used our shape soft play outdoors to create our own rockets and pretend that we were heading to the moon!

Main Forest

This week, we were challenging our abilities. The children designed and made swings, a zip wire and walking rope to push their core skills.

Firstly, we talked about the correct knots that should be used for the strongest grip then Year 3 made an acrobat swing so that they could hang upside down, Year 6 tied rope to the highest point of the tree so they could use it to climb up the tree just using the rope and their feet.

The other classes made balancing beams seesaws and assault courses.

Children have been displaying courage, determination and pride and our GROW standard of WISDOM when tackling the areas.

We took some spring flowers and leaves and made Hapa Zone patterns on fabric. The children confidently hammered the flowers onto the fabric making different patterns and watched the colourings of the different flowers and leaves come out on their fabric.

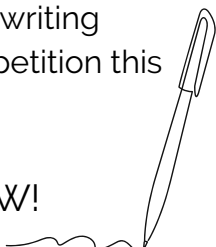


Well done to Evie-Mae for winning a bronze and silver medal in her gymnastics county competition.
