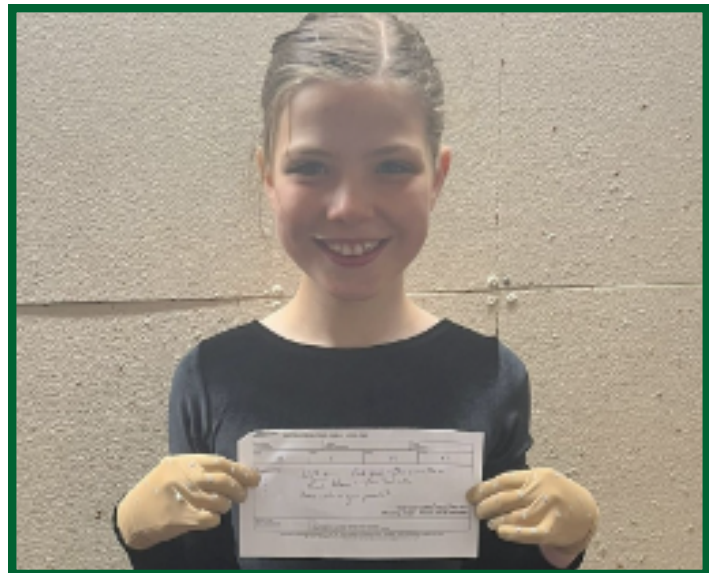


GROWING BEYOND SCHOOL
