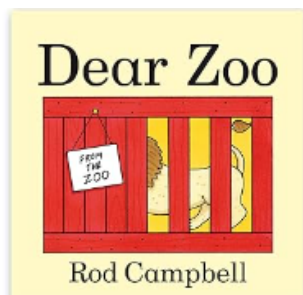
## NEWS FROM PRESCHOOL
