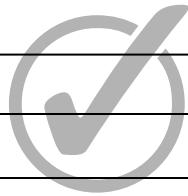

The children excitedly explored the areas and discussed how the forest has changed while they had been away.

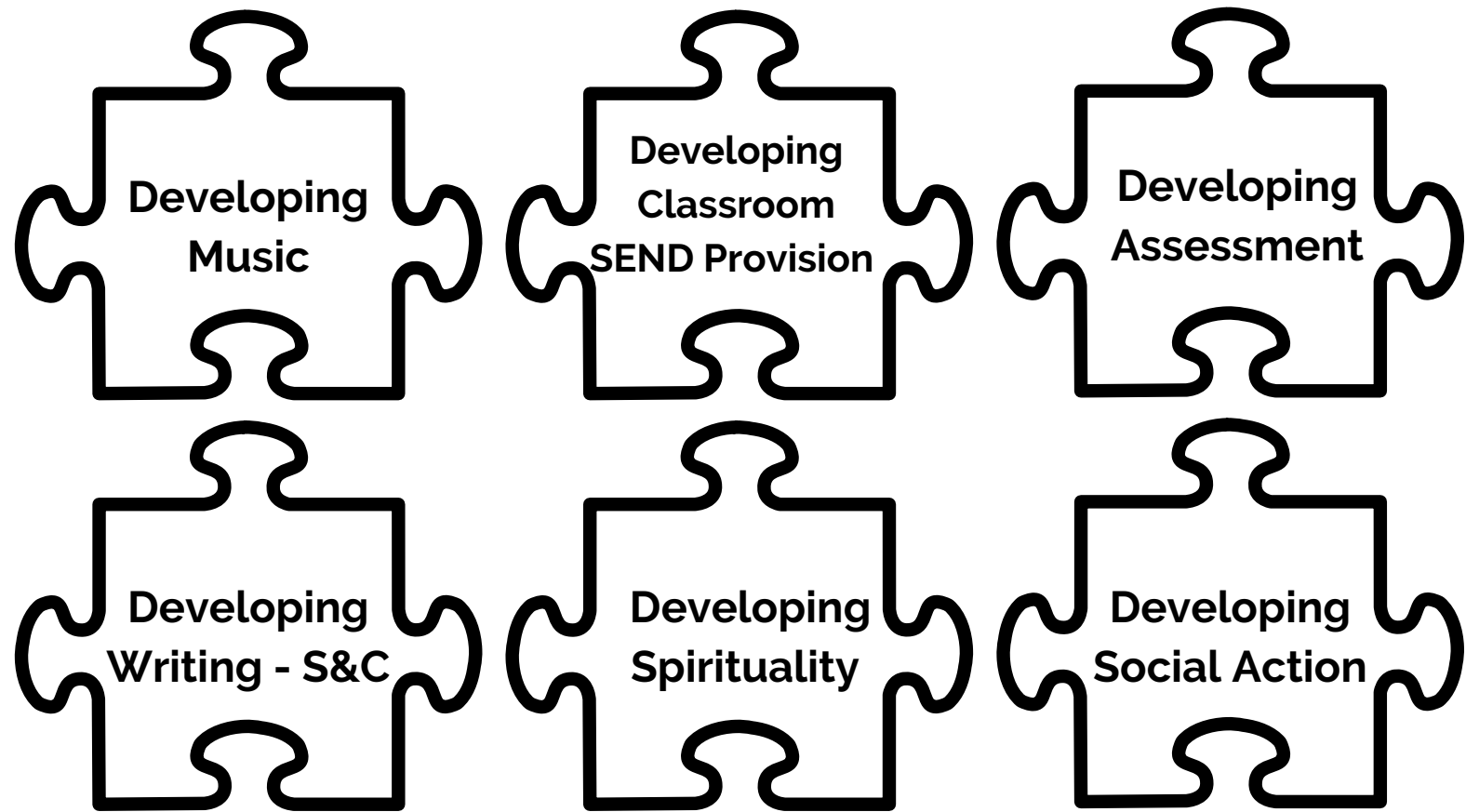
It was nice to see the new EYFS children enjoying their first experience of forest school... let's hope the nice weather continues for a bit longer!

Our wonderful site manager, Mr Johnson, has a plea to our lovely school community...

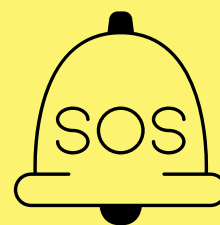
### He needs rocks!
