

The children have continued last week's interest of Science by taking part in a colour changing daffodil experiment, and they have explored growth whilst setting cress seeds. The butterflies have been busy whilst using a range of materials to create birds nests, and they have used their imaginations whilst playing in our seasonal themed vets. The children were also lucky enough to conclude the week with a lovely visit from one of our Preschool parents who is a veterinary nurse and came to speak to the children about her job role.
