Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to ask for your support in an important matter concerning the safety of our children on their journeys to and from school.

As you may have seen in recent communications, the school crossing patrol, which has helped keep our children safe for many years, was removed by the council last week. We are very grateful to our local councillors who have secured temporary funding to keep Lisa, our valued crossing patrol officer, in place until the end of this academic year. However, there is currently no plan for what will happen after July, and there is still no suitable permanent crossing provision in place.

This is where we need your help. A petition is now available, and we are asking all parents, carers, and community members to sign it to show your support for keeping a safe crossing option in place until a permanent solution is provided. The more signatures we gather, the stronger our case will be when it is presented at the next full council meeting.

To make it easy for everyone to sign, clipboards with the petition will be placed on tables in the playground and near the bike sheds next week. Please take a moment at drop-off or pick-up to sign your name and support this vital cause.

Our School Social Action Team is also working hard by writing letters to the council to highlight the importance of this issue from the children's perspective. This is a real opportunity for us to make our voices heard and to stand together as a community in support of the safety and wellbeing of all our pupils.
