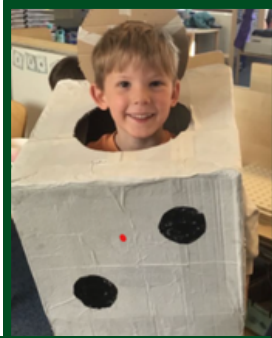

Caterpillars Class

This week in Caterpillars, we have been exploring the theme of dental hygiene.

The children engaged in group discussions, sharing their own dental experiences and learning from one another. In our home corner, they enjoyed role-playing in our very own 'dental practice', taking on the roles of dentists and patients.

We also practiced cleaning the babies' teeth using toothbrushes, helping to reinforce good brushing habits. To extend the learning, the children used toothbrushes in creative ways—painting and making marks, combining sensory play with artistic expression.

The children have also been exploring weight and measurement this week by using weighing scales, developing their understanding of balance, comparison, and early math concepts through hands-on play.

Butterflies Class

This week in Butterflies, we've been focusing on the beloved story, We're going on a Bear Hunt. The children engaged in thoughtful discussions about the characters and key events in the book, which led to some lovely conversations about our own families, the special people in our lives, and the emotions we all experience.

Throughout the week, the children have taken part in a variety of bear themed mathematical activities, where they have explored concepts such as size, measurement, and weight. The children have taken part in an exciting reenactment of the story where they travelled through a series of sensory trays filled with materials such as soil, shaving foam, and grass - each representing a different scene from the book. As they explored each of the trays, the children eagerly joined in with retelling the tale, where they used expressive language and animated movements to truly bring the adventure to life! Alongside their imaginative storytelling, the children have also been creative, designing their own bear masks and crafting beautiful storyboards. Using a range of materials such as grass and twigs, the children carefully sequenced each part of the story, developing their storytelling skills in a fun and interactive way!





NEWS FROM THE FOREST

The forest was buzzing with ideas this week as the children thought about what they could add to make it even more fun for everyone. From adventurous assault courses and tricky climbing frames, to muddy restaurants and cosy chill-out spots – the imagination was flowing!
