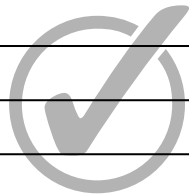

Well done to Lewis who was chosen as 'manager's player' at his football presentation. A great achievement, Lewis! Keep working hard.



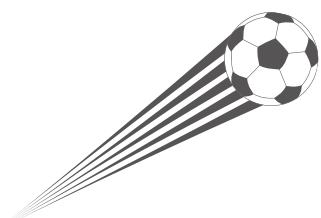

### Caterpillars Class

This week, we revisited our popular core story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar.

We followed the little caterpillar on his journey as he munched his way through lots of tasty food and turned into a beautiful butterfly. Along the way, we talked about the days of the week, different types of healthy and unhealthy food, and how caterpillars grow and change. The children have made their own colorful caterpillars and butterflies with paint, paper, and lots of creativity. Our classroom looks amazing! We learned about the life cycle of a butterfly and we tasted some of the fruits from the story and talked about which foods help us grow strong and healthy.

### Butterflies Class

This week in preschool, we kicked off the week by learning all about Trooping the Colour. The children were absolutely captivated as they watched clips of the Royal Family, the grand parade, and the spectacular flypast - with the Red Arrows' dazzling display most certainly stealing the show! Midweek, our focus shifted to the vibrant story of Handa's Surprise. The children explored the array of exotic fruits featured in the tale, using rich and expressive language to describe their colours, textures, and tastes. We also watched a short clip, A Day in the Life of Handa, which inspired some fantastic discussions about the similarities and differences between life in Africa and life here in England. Our artistic talents shone through during fruit-themed portrait drawing, while our safari-themed tuff tray became a hotspot for discovery. The children also demonstrated wonderful independence as they used safety knives to carefully create their own fruit kebabs, using and trying tropical fruits from the story, such as pineapple, mango, and avocado. We then wrapped up the week in the best way possible - with music and water play! With their feet dipped in paddling pools and tapping sticks in hand, the children explored rhythm and sound, all while keeping cool under the summer sun. This was certainly a joyful, refreshing experience enjoyed by all!

## NEWS FROM THE FOREST

This week in the forest, we've continued exploring our friendship theme. The children have been working together to build dens, play imaginatively, and take positive risks. It's been wonderful to see them fully engaged in the forest environment, trying new things, embracing challenges, and deepening their connections with one another. Their teamwork, resilience, and joy in learning outdoors has truly shone through! As the weather is warming up and a possible heatwave is on the way, we wanted to share some guidance to help ensure your children stay comfortable and safe during our forest sessions. Although temperatures are rising, the forest remains shaded and significantly cooler. With that in mind, we kindly ask that children continue to wear long trousers. Lightweight pyjama bottoms are a great option, as they help protect against scratches, bites, and long grass while keeping children cool.

Please also provide:

- A lightweight long-sleeved top – again, pyjama tops work well.
- A change of shoes – either trainers or wellies are fine (please be aware they may get muddy or wet).
- A fleece or lightweight jacket – ideal for cooler areas of the forest or when out of the sun. This can be easily removed when not needed.
- Water bottle
