On this day, we are inviting the children to come to school dressed in a Christmas jumper or other festive item of clothing. In doing so, we would ask that you make a donation to Save the Children to contribute to the amazing work that they do in the UK and around the world. The money that we raise could go towards some amazing things like:
