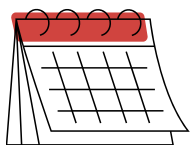

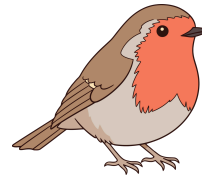
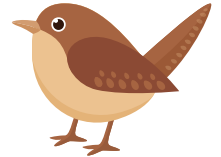
PRESCHOOL NEWS
