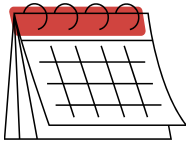
THIS WEEK AT EYE C OF E PRIMARY...

A big well done to Arthur, Reggie, Jack, Charles, Elliot, Florence Mia and Mia.

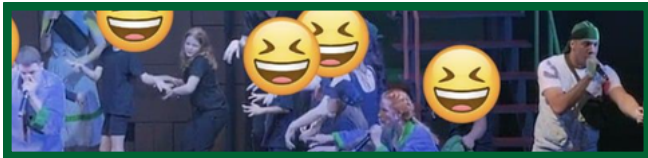


GROWING BEYOND SCHOOL

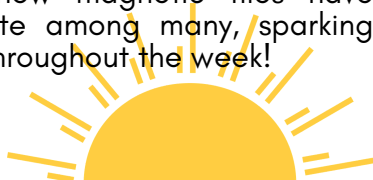
