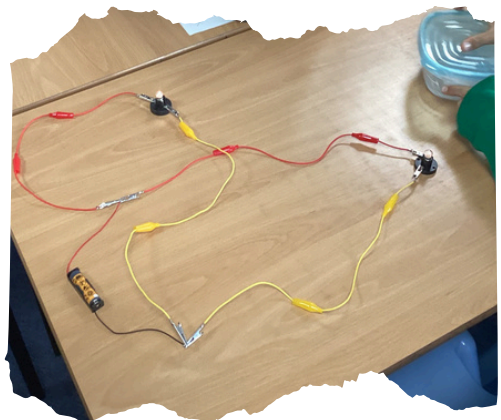
We also wanted to share a little peek at how your amazing support has helped over the past year.
