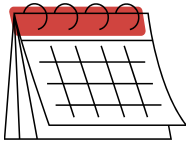
THIS WEEK AT EYE C OF E PRIMARY...

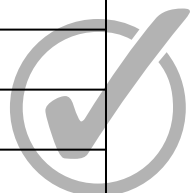
