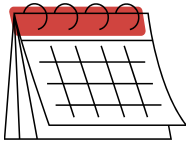
THIS WEEK AT EYE C OF E PRIMARY...

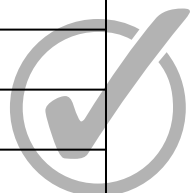

PRESCHOOL NEWS

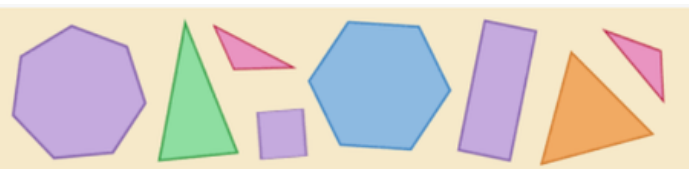
This week, we have begun our exciting learning journey all about plants!
