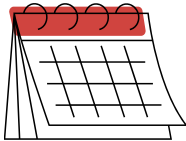

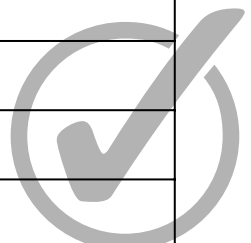

This week in Preschool, we have been exploring sea animals, learning about where they live, what they eat and the different habitats they call home. The children have enjoyed investigating sea creatures in the tuff tray, creating their own colourful crabs and jellyfish, whilst developing their maths and literacy skills. It has also been a very busy week! We enjoyed taking part in Sports Day, watching the school plays, and supporting our older children as they took part in their school transition visits, helping them prepare for their exciting next step.

EYFS TRIP

What a fabulous day Squirrels and Hedgehogs had at the zoo. Everybody was on their best behaviour (apart from the goats!) and the weather was beautiful. It was a wonderful opportunity for the children to see for themselves some of the amazing animals we have discussed in our learning this year. The pumas and lions proved popular, along with the capybaras and their babies. We were then able to finish our day with a well earned visit to the park. The children represented Eye School perfectly throughout the day. Well done boys and girls, we hope that you enjoyed your day as much as we did!



YEAR 4 TRIP

Year 4 ventured to Peterborough Cathedral on Monday and were absolutely amazed by what they discovered. We were surprised to learn just how much Anglo-Saxon history took place right here on our doorstep. The children fully immersed themselves as archaeologists, carefully examining a range of artefacts, including the Hedda Stone and a glass pot from the period, making thoughtful predictions and assumptions about what they might have been used for. We also explored the timeline of Anglo-Saxon kings and queens and how their stories helped to shape Britain as we know it today. It was fascinating to see how events from so long ago still influence our history. To finish, the children learnt how to create their own ink and practised writing using quills, producing their own Anglo-Saxon chronicle. We left with a wealth of new knowledge, vivid memories and a real appreciation for the rich history so close to home.
